Our package rates (available upon request) are for **exclusive use** of the entire resort not per number of persons.

All prices include complimentary use of hotel amenities including chemical free salt water swimming pool, free use of bicycles and snorkelling equipment, on-site reception and tour desk open 7 days and housekeeping.

FAQ

Q How do I get to Raro?

A. *We have direct flights weekly from LA, Sydney and Tahiti as well as daily flights from Auckland.*

Q. How many people can we bring?

A. *Ikurangi is designed to comfortably host up to 14 guests.*

Q. Do you have a dedicated space on which our group can practise yoga?

A. *Yes! We have a large (4.8m x 9m) multi-purpose undercover platform for yoga and dining together, all weather. We also have an expansive lawn area, if preferred, on fine days.*

Q. How do we get around?

A. *We have six bicycles on site which are complimentary to use and there is a reliable bus service. We do, however, recommend hiring a car/van to make the most of your stay on Rarotonga. A rental vehicle is by far the most economical way for a group to get around (prices range from approx. \$40/day/sedan up to \$100/day/15-seater).*

Q. What type of cuisine is included in the Polynesian Zen Package?

A. *All meals are vegetarian or with some seafood using the freshest, locally grown, seasonal produce. Lunches are pre-packaged for you to enjoy on site or take away to eat elsewhere. Dinners are served at Ikurangi and are either delicious shared Island Platters or buffet style Bowls of Goodness. We support three local caterers that are highly rated.*

Q. What dining options are there for days Ikurangi aren't supplying meals?

A. *Lunch or dinner are included on some of the tours and we always recommend a Saturday morning outing to the local Punanga Nui Market for lunch as well as the Muri Night Markets open several nights a week for dinner. There are excellent restaurants to cater to everyone's tastes and budgets and we've learnt from experience that guests like to get out and explore the local food scene.*

Q. Can you cater for dietary requirements?

A. *Yes, with ample notice, we can cater to most dietary needs including vegan, gluten free and lactose intolerant.*





Terms and Conditions

Valid from 1-April-2020 to 31-March-2021 (may be subject to change).

All bookings are subject to availability and must be made directly with Ikurangi Eco Retreat.

A 20% deposit is required at time of booking to secure dates and can be paid by credit card (+ processing fees) or by ITT (bank fees apply). The remaining balance is due 60 days prior to arrival.

Please be aware of our Exclusive Group Cancellation/Amendment Policy, which is as follows:

- Cancellations made 90 days or more from arrival no fee
- Cancellations made 89-59 days from arrival will be charged the deposit (plus any processing fees)
- Cancellations made 60 days or less of arrival will be charged the full amount of the stay (plus any processing fees)
- No shows and early departures will be charged full amount (plus any processing fees)
